# position of the prosecutor, universally

- Criminal law – general and special prevention of crimes
- Gatekeeper to the judge
- Powerful position
- Part of a chain: victim-police-prosecutor-judge-prison-probation
- International




# expectations by society



- Enforcement of the rule of law
  - by credible interventions against criminal behaviour
  - only by *prosecuting* criminal offences ??
- Effective
- Results:
  - national internal security (in control)
  - objective and subjective awareness of safety

# co-operation as a mission

- All by yourself = DANGER
  - dependent on others (chain )
  - prosecution service will be blamed
- Work together:
  - with other public administrations
  - with private organisations
- Balance of prevention and repression

- Financial sector
- ICT sector
- Football
- Medical sector

# public administration

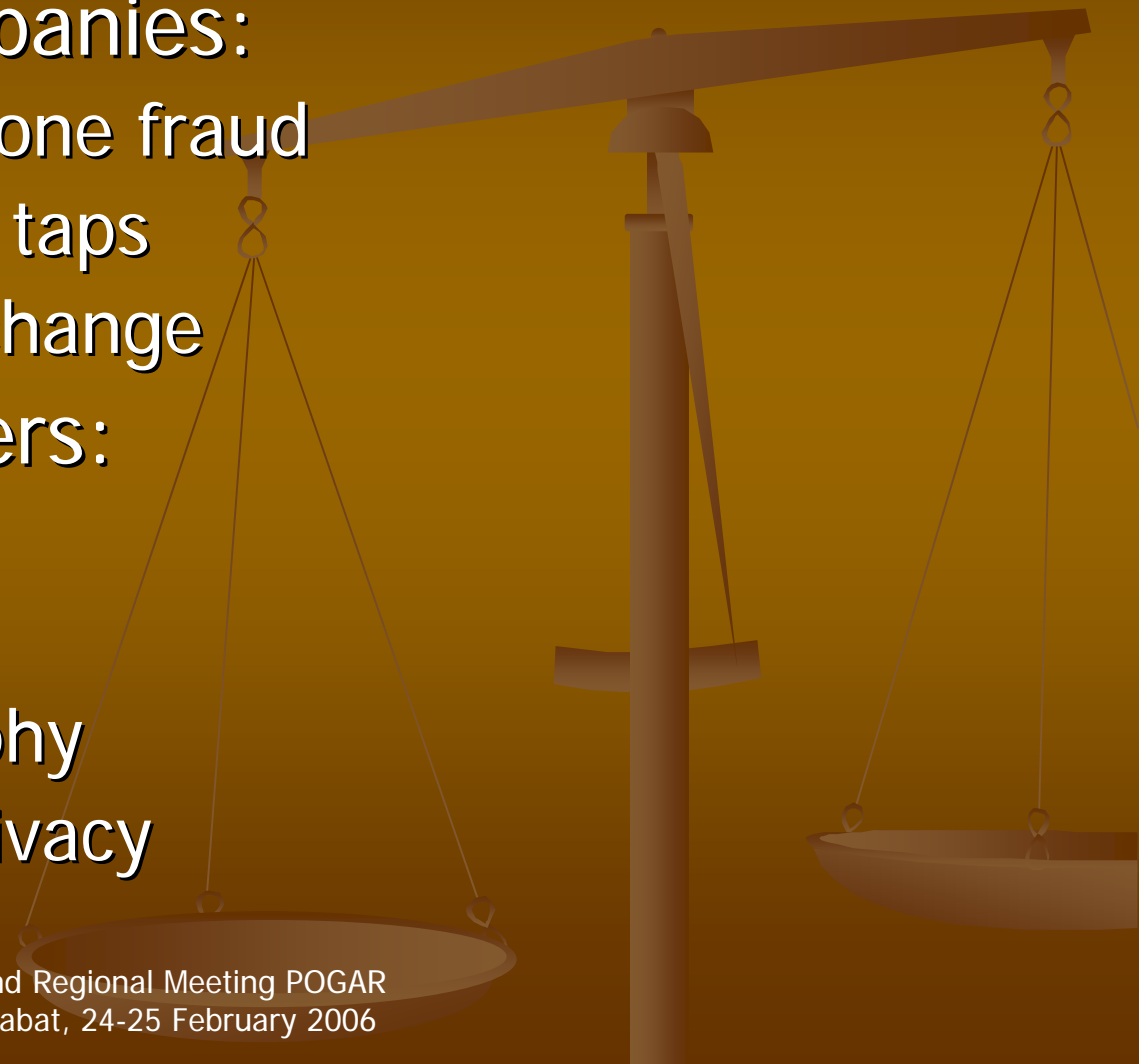
- Primary partner for prosecutor
  - municipal administration
  - national administration
- Integral safety policies
  - priorities for law enforcement
- Concrete actions, e.g.:
  - cameras in streets
  - licences
  - combat of drugs dealing

# financial sector

- Banks:
  - money laundering
  - financial transactions
  - bank robberies
  - use of cameras
- Insurance companies:
  - fraud
  - civil actions
- Shops: thefts

# ICT sector

- Telephone companies:
  - (mobile) telephone fraud
  - easy telephone taps
  - information exchange
- Internet providers:
  - computerfraud
  - virusses
  - child pornography
  - protocols on privacy



# football

- (or: “soccer”)
- Nice game, serious aggression
  - agreements with National Football league
  - agreements with individual clubs
  - investments in security people
- Transportation of supporters:
  - national railway company
- Sanctions by municipal administration

# medical sector

- Medical information:
  - victims
  - expert-witness
- Psychiatric reports
- Mutual respect:
  - matters of privacy
  - need for information
- Violence in hospitals



# children's protection

- Council for children's protection
- Specially trained police
- Municipal programmes:
  - treatment of deviant children
  - funds for stimulation of backward children
- Agreements with schools:
  - crimes at school
  - skipping school

# rehabilitation



- Prisons
  - prosecution service responsible for execution
- Probation
  - advice reports
  - coerced supervising of offenders
  - learning projects
- Projects “working for the community”

# conclusions

- Part of the chain 
  - working together
  - own responsibility
- Prosecutors' role:
  - legitimacy of police investigations
  - legitimacy of integral safety policies
  - coercion by own powers
